- Please submit a recommendation from a teacher who is able to attest to your talent <u>in the area for which you are applying</u>. WRITING STAFF APPLICANTS ONLY:

- Write a 250-word mock news article on the following fictional occurrence. Make up all the important details and quotes for the article to make sense and be accurately reported. *The Talon* is looking for a realistically news-like and serious tone that emulates a professional news article.  - o The Fight Against Cancer Club held a bake sale fundraiser in the quad during lunch.
- Select <u>one</u> of the two following prompts and write an article no longer than 400 words. The article should demonstrate strong voice, command of the English language, and professionalism. Consult the *Talon* archives on lahstalon.org, or other professional papers for examples.
 - o Write an entertainment-style review on a book, movie, restaurant or videogame of your choice.
 - Write a game day article about a high school sport of your choice. The article should focus on the key points of one game.

PHOTOGRAPHY STAFF APPLICANTS ONLY:

• Attach a sample of your work. In addition to what you consider your best photos, include several clear <u>action shots</u> that you think could be printed in a newspaper.

GRAPHIC ARTIST APPLICANTS ONLY:

- Attach samples of what you consider to be your best work. You may submit as many samples as you think accurately reflect your work and style. Submissions may be hand drawn or created digitally.
- Create and attach graphics in response to each of these two prompts. The best graphics include people.
